### Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you: information that you provide by filling in forms on our site. This includes information provided at the time of registration or at the time of posting material if you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence; we may ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes although you do not have to respond to them; details of transactions you carry out through our site and of the fulfillment of any contract between us; details of your visits to our site and the resources that you access.

### IP Addresses and Cookies

We may collect information about your computer including, where available, your IP address, operating system and browser type for system administration. This is data about our users' browsing actions and patterns and does not identify any individual. We will not collect information from you other than that provided by your browser in normal use.

We may use cookies in our web site which contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. Cookies enable us to improve our site and to deliver more personalised service. For example to::

estimate our audience size and usage pattern;	store information about your
preferences and tailor our site according to individual interests;	speed-up searches;
recognise when you return to the Ulric Publishing web site.	

We do not use cookies to gather information from you other than information about our own website.

### About Cookies

A cookie, also known as a HTTP cookie, web cookie, or browser cookie, is a piece of data stored by a website within a browser, and then subsequently sent back to the same website by the browser. Cookies are a reliable mechanism for websites to remember past activity.

Although cookies cannot carry viruses, and cannot install malware on the host computer, tracking cookies and especially third party tracking cookies are commonly used as a way to compile long-term records of individuals' browsing histories.

Cookies also perform essential functions in the modern web. Authentication cookies are the most common method used by web servers to establish whether a given user is logged in (or not), and user-account login I.D.

### How to control and delete cookies

Ulric Publishing does not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information. However, if you wish to restrict or block the cookies which are set by the Ulric Publishing website you can do this through your browser settings. The Help function within your browser should tell you how. Restricting cookies may influence the functionality of the Ulric Publishing website.

### Where we store your personal data

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to and stored at a destination outside the European Economic Area. By submitting your personal data you agree to this transfer. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy & Cookie Policy.

We do not store credit-or debit card information. Any [other] information you provide to us may be stored on our secure servers. Where we have provided you (or where you have chosen) a password, user ID or PIN which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password, user ID or PIN confidential. We ask you not to share a password; user ID or PIN with anyone

The transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. While we do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot ensure the security of your data transmitted to our site. Any transmission is entirely at your own risk. Once we have received your information we will use strict procedures and security features to prevent unauthorised access.

### **Uses made of the information**

We use information held about you in the following ways:

to ensure that content from our web site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;  
to provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you;  
to allow you to participate in interactive features of our service where you choose to do so; to notify you about changes to our service; to analyse information about our users in order to identify their potential preferences.

We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries as defined in section 736 of the *UK Companies Act 1985* [The Act].

We will not disclose your data to any third party outside our group for direct marketing but we may from time to time provide you with information about goods and services which we feel may be of interest to you including those provided by third parties.

Your postal address and telephone number will be registered on file for 5 years from the date of your last contact.

### **Your rights**
